

State law now requires that a person who is not a citizen or legal resident of the United States or who is without lawful immigration status is not entitled to classification as an in-state student for tuition purposes pursuant to A.R.S. Section 15-1802. The responsibility of providing the proper residency documentation is placed upon the student. Any student who falsifies his/her residency may be subject to dismissal from the university.

Arizona State University Acceptable Documents

The following is a list of acceptable documents to verify a student's citizenship, legal resident or other lawful presence status for purposes of determining eligibility for in-state tuition. Documents may be emailed, mailed, faxed, or submitted in person. Documentation that is submitted via fax or mail must be legible with no evidence of tampering. Final residency decisions for tuition purposes will be made in accordance with A.R.S. §15-1801 *et. seq.*, as well as the policies and regulations of the Arizona Board of Regents and Arizona State University.
