Residency Classification Petition: Dependent of an Arizona Resident

Dependent students must document that they and one of their parents are permanently domiciled in Arizona and that their parent is eligible to claim the student as a dependent for federal and state tax purposes. Residency classification is based on guidelines provided by the Arizona Board of Regents (ABOR) in compliance with current Arizona state law. Per ABOR policy 4-203.C.1, a dependent is eligible to be classified as a resident for tuition purposes if he/she has provided clear and convincing evidence of the following:

- The student and parent have followed Arizona state laws regarding intent, and
- Permanent domicile was established in Arizona by both the parent and the student on or before the appropriate petition deadline, and
- The student's parent is eligible to claim the student as a qualifying child for federal tax purposes.

Deadlines:

1. Per ABOR requirements, failure to submit a notarized petition by the deadline date constitutes a waiver of the right to petition for that term. There is no appeal process for petitions submitted after the deadline. Requests received after the deadline will be denied.

¹ Fully completed petitions, including all required documentation, submitted before the priority deadline will be evaluated prior to the first day of classes. Petitions submitted after this date will be reviewed in the order in which they are received, but may not be evaluated until after classes begin.

Student Responsibilities:

- 1. You are responsible for paying <u>all</u> tuition charges, as they stand, by the tuition deadline date. Having a petition pending does not waive this responsibility. Tuition balances <u>not</u> paid in full by the tuition deadline will be subject to late fees and payment plans per University policy. IF your petition is approved, a refund of the tuition difference will be generated. Fees are not refunded.
- 2. Petitions are reviewed in the order they are received and student's who need an early decision are encouraged to submit their petitions as early as possible.
- 3. Certain financial aid may be reduced, adjusted or cancelled if your status changes to resident. It is the student's responsibility to contact a financial aid counselor to determine if your residency classification affects your financial aid. If residency is approved after financial aid is disbursed, the student may be obligated to return a portion of their financial aid.
- 4. The burden of proof rests with the student and it is your responsibility to properly document compliance with all residency requirements. Petitions are evaluated and decisions are rendered based on the credibility and authenticity of the documentation provided. Students are expected to read and understand all policies and procedures related to residency and lack of knowledge will not excuse requisite compliance with current state law.
- 5. Students are expected to be truthful and forthcoming with information relevant to residency. Petitioners who have omitted, falsified, or misrepresented any information will be referred to Student Rights and Responsibilities for disciplinary action.
- 6. Residency petitions are only accepted from students who have been admitted to ASU.

Appeals:

- 1. If your petition is denied, per ABOR policy you have the right to appeal your decision.
- 2. Additional information is available at: https://students.asu.edu/residencyappeals.
- 3. All students are encouraged to speak with a residency classification specialist before submitting an appeal.
- 4. Appeal deadlines will be communicated to you in your decision letter; appeals requested after this deadline will be denied.
- 5. Appeals for petitions submitted after the petition deadline will not be considered.

ABOR Policy:

Your petition will be evaluated per ABOR policy, which includes, but is not limited to, the following statements:

- "Domicile" means a person's true, fixed and permanent home and place of habitation. It is the place where the person intends to remain, and to which the person intends to return when leaving without intending to establish a new domicile elsewhere.
- "Parent" means an individual's father or mother, or a the legal guardian of an unemancipated individual provided there is no evidence indicating that the guardianship was created primarily for the purpose of conferring the classification of resident on the individual.
- In determining residency classification, any relevant evidence may be considered, including...Objective evidence of intent to be a resident for tuition purposes of Arizona as demonstrated by the severance of ties to the individual's former state of residence.
